DIRECTIONS TO CROWN POINT

From the south on I-71

Take I-271 North to Richfield Exit 9. Turn right onto Brecksville Road (which becomes Cleveland-Massillon Road). Go to the third traffic light (Ira Road, also know as Hammonds Corner). Turn left on Ira. Crown Point is on the right about a mile east on Ira.

From the south on I-77

Exit at Ghent Road (Exit 138). Turn left onto Ghent and then immediately get into the right lane on Ghent. Note, at this point, Ghent merges into Cleveland-Massillon Road at the next traffic light—less than 300 feet from the off ramp. Follow Cleveland-Massillon Road to Ira Road. Turn right at Ira. Crown Point is on the right about a mile east on Ira.



From the north on I-77

Exit at Wheatley Rd (Exit 143). Turn right off the ramp. At the traffic light, turn left onto Brecksville Road (which becomes Cleveland-Massillon Road). Turn left at the second traffic light which is Ira Road. Crown Point is on the right about a mile east on Ira.

From the north on I-71

Take any route (480, 82, 303) east to I-77. Follow directions above for I-77 from the North

From the north on I-271

Take I-77 south. Stay to the right. DO NOT MERGE LEFT. Exit immediately at Richfield Exit 143. Turn right off the ramp. At the traffic light, turn left onto Brecksville Road. (Brecksville Road becomes Cleveland-Massillon Road. You will be traveling south.) Turn left at the second traffic light which is Ira Road. Crown Point is on the right about a mile east on Ira.



From Route 303

Turn south on Riverview Road in Peninsula. Turn right onto Ira Road. Follow Ira Road up the hill 1.5 miles past Hale Farm. Crown Point is on the left, just past Revere Road.
